Interested Contractors may examine or obtain a copy of the Contract Documents during normal working hours at the Lower Providence Township Municipal Building 100 Parklane Drive, Eagleville, PA 19403. The fee for a copy of the contract document is \$50.00. The work involved the furnishing of all labor, materials, transportation, tools, supplies, and equipment necessary for the paving, grading and drainage work included for the installation of concrete sidewalk, concrete curb removal and replacement, roadway/driveway restoration, and ADA ramps in accordance with the contract documents. Sealed bids will be received by the Township Manager until 11:00 am, Tuesday, December 11, 2018 in the municipal building at 100 Parklane Drive. Bids will be opened on the same day at the same location at approximately 11:05am. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and shall be marked clearly as follows: "Sealed Bid Proposal for Park Pointe Sidewalk Expansion." Requirements for a ten (10%) percent bid bond, 100% performance bond, 100% payment bond, ten (10%) maintenance bond and contractor's insurance are included in the contract documents. There will be a mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting held at the Lower Providence Township Building at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday December 4, 2018.
