

1. If firm applies and is awarded the Master Plan, does that eliminate the firm from applying for architectural projects at Washington USD? **No. However, our District is currently under Master Agreement with Architectural firms that were awarded through an RFP issued in 2015. With the potentially large volume of projects that may be inspired by the Facilities Master Plan, the District will most likely issue an updated RFP for additional/new architectural firms. The firm awarded the Facilities Master Plan contract will benefit from the research applied during the Master Planning which will most likely help prepare the firm for a comprehensive proposal for a Master Agreement for architectural services when the RFP is issued. As noted in the Facilities Needs Presentation future projects listed within the completed Master Plan are pending approval of a future bond.**
