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SOLICITATION AMENDMENT

Amendment Number Two (2)

This amendment supplements and amends the original solicitation and shall be taken into account in preparing proposals, and become a part of the Contract Documents. In case of conflict between the original solicitation and this amendment, this amendment shall govern. Careful note of this amendment must be taken by the offeror.

This proposal is amended as follows:

1. Page 8 of 19 – Section A(2) – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The above school sites are located within the district boundaries of the Alhambra Elementary School District. Four of the sites are within the City of Phoenix and one site is within the City of Glendale, and within the City of Phoenix, all within Maricopa County, Arizona.

2. Page 8 of 19 – Section B – CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

The established select bidders list will receive an Invitation for Bid for the identified projects. After competitive sealed bidding, the District reserves the right to award to one or more than one Offeror grouped by two or more sites or individual sites whichever is advantageous to the District. The District is seeking advantageous and competitive pricing by offering invitations for bids on this project through qualified selected bidders. The District, in its sole discretion, specifically notifies prospective Offerors that the District reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or any portions thereof, and to later procure any or all portions of the project from another procurement and construction delivery method; including, but not limited to, any future District solicitation for Job-Order-Contracting construction services or any current cooperative purchase procurement for Job-Order-Contract construction services under which the District is a cooperative purchasing member eligible to procure these services.

3. Page 9 of 10 – Section 2 – PURPOSE

This Request for Qualifications shall not commit the District to enter into any contract or agreement, to pay any expenses incurred in preparation of any response to this request, or to procure or contract for any supplies, goods or services. The District reserves the right to accept or reject any and all responses received as a result of this RFQ if it is in the District’s best interest to do so. The District intends to issue an Invitation for Bid to the qualified select bidders list for the identified project, and intends to award to the successful bidder(s) a contract for construction pursuant to the terms and conditions of competitive sealed bidding under the Arizona School District Procurement Code. The District is seeking advantageous and competitive pricing by offering invitations for bids on this project through qualified selected bidders. The District, in its sole discretion, specifically notifies prospective Offerors that the District reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or any portions thereof, and to later procure any or all portions of the project from another procurement and construction delivery method;

including, but not limited to, any future District solicitation for Job-Order-Contracting construction services or any current cooperative purchase procurement for Job-Order-Contract construction services under which the District is a cooperative purchasing member eligible to procure these services.

4. Page 10 of 19 – Section 4(A)(i) - EVALUATION CRITERIA

- A. General Experience of the Offeror (20 points)
 - i. The overall experience and expertise of the Offeror, specifically in providing school construction services for K-12 schools or public entity projects within the State of Arizona.
