Description: Remove three existing boilers, three water tanks, and expansion tanks in “E”, “F”, and “G” units at SYSC. Replace each with two high efficiency boilers, two high efficiency hot water heaters and two expansion tanks. Cutting and welding of ship ladders and handrails will be necessary to fit the equipment through the tight confines of the access route.

The Project will include the Discipline(s) of: Metals, Mechanical, Electrical.

In order to be authorized to bid, the Department’s Request for Proposal (RFP) form must be submitted to the Contract Office of the Department of Transportation. Once the RFP has been approved, the Contractor is authorized to bid. At this time, the password card will be issued allowing the Contractor access to the online bidding documents, including Plans and Specifications. Hard copies of the Bidding Documents can be obtained from the NH Department of Transportation, Finance & Contracts Office, Room 130, Concord, NH 03302-0483. AN ADDITIONAL \$10.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR SHIPPING. Checks are to be made payable to “Treasurer, State of New Hampshire”. Send check with project name and number to NH Department of Transportation, c/o Finance & Contracts, P.O. Box 483, Concord, NH 03302-0483.

BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE,

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 22, 2020, BEGINNING AT 9:00AM AT 1056 RIVER ROAD, MANCHESTER, N.H. PRE-BID CONFERENCE SHEET MUST BE SIGNED AT BEGINNING AND END OF CONFERENCE TO QUALIFY FOR BIDDING. NO EXCEPTIONS ALLOWED.

Project completion date is March 5, 2020.

Proposals must be submitted electronically via <https://icx.exevision.com/nhdot/icx/Index.aspx> and received by the Department of Transportation as specified above no later than the date and time mentioned above, at which time they will be publicly opened and the results immediately posted on the Department's website. A bid bond shall be submitted electronically at the time of bid in the amount listed below, payable to, "Treasurer, State of New Hampshire," as security for the execution of the contract.

All individuals, firms, partnerships or corporations intending to bid, before obtaining plans and specifications, must file with the Department of Transportation on forms prepared for that purpose at least ten (10) days prior to opening of bids, a statement showing their qualifications. No valid bidding proposal will be issued to a prospective bidder who is not qualified.

Companies, corporations or trade names, except sole proprietorships must be registered with the Secretary of State (Corporate Division, Telephone No. 603/271-3244) in order to do business with the State of New Hampshire.


PER SECTION 00204.18.2, LOW BIDDER HAS TEN (10) DAYS AFTER NOTICE OF AWARD TO SUBMIT SIGNED CONTRACT, CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE, AND DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE FORM, IF REQUIRED.

Bidders are advised that final bid award, as approved by Governor and Executive Council, and issuance of a notification to proceed with the work, can occur up to 60 days or more after the bid opening date.

WORK SHALL BEGIN IMMEDIATELY UPON AWARD OF CONTRACT.

Bidders must submit a 5% bid security at Bid and must furnish a 100% payment and performance security prior to execution of contract.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in or to reject any or all proposals.
