DESCRIPTION

The Buffalo Township Municipal Sewer Authority (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

**Buffalo Crossroads Pump Station Rehabilitation
Contract 2020-01: General Construction**

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received until Tuesday, February 4, 2020 at 1:00 PM, local time. At that time the Bids received will be publically opened online, as well as at the office of Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc. (HRG), 776 Bull Run Crossing, Suite 200, Lewisburg, PA 17837.

The Project includes the following Work: Repair and replacement of wet well and valve vault piping and appurtenances, cured-in-place pipe lining between wet well and upstream manhole, and replacement of an offsite sanitary manhole. Alternate Bid items include rehabilitation of existing wet well and valve vault.

Information and Bidding Documents for the Project can be obtained online at no charge via the designated website, PennBid: <https://PennBid.ProcureWare.com>. Prospective Bidders are urged to register with the designated website as a plan holder, even if Bidding Documents are obtained in either electronic or paper format from a plan room or source other than the designated website. The designated website will be updated periodically with addenda, lists of registered plan holders, reports, and other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through the designated website. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

For Bidders without access to PennBid, Bidding Documents can be purchased for a cost of \$185 through HRG at 776 Bull Run Crossing, Suite 200, Lewisburg, PA 17837.

Prospective Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at HRG's Lewisburg Office, Monday-Friday, 9AM-4PM. Acceptance of hard-copy Bids will be accommodated in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a Certified Check or Bid Bond shall be furnished with the Bid in an amount not less than 10%.

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Bidding Documents are to be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Telephone inquiries are unacceptable.

For all further requirements regarding Bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

Bidders must comply with all State antibid-rigging regulations pertaining to work associated with this Project, and will be required to submit an executed non-collusion affidavit with the Bid.

Bidders should refer to provisions of federal and state statutes, rules and regulations dealing with the prevention of environmental pollution and preservation of public natural resources that affect the Project, pursuant to Act No. 247 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved October 26, 1972.

This Project falls under The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania enacted Act 127 of 2012, known as the Public Works Employment Verification Act ('the Act') which requires all public works contractors and subcontractors to utilize the Federal Government's E-Verify system to ensure that all employees performing work on public works projects are authorized to work in the United States. All Bidders are required to submit a Public Works Employment Verification Form as a precondition for the Contract Award.

In addition to the Equal Employment requirements of Executive Order 11246 regarding discrimination, the Contractor must establish a 6.9% goal for female participation and a 1% goal for minority participation in his/her aggregate on-site construction workforce for contracts in excess of \$10,000.

The Buffalo Township Municipal Sewer Authority is utilizing federal funds for this Project, and Union County has adopted a Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) in accordance with Executive Orders 11625, 12138, and 12432 and a Section 3 Action Plan in accordance with Title 24 Part 135 Code of Federal Regulations. As such, the Bidders/Offerors must submit documentary evidence of minority and women business enterprises and Section 3 business concerns who have been contacted and to whom commitments have been made. Documentation of such solicitations and commitments shall be submitted with the Bid.

Moreover, the Contractor shall strive to meet the MBE goal of 5% and the WBE goal of 3% for contracts of \$25,000 or more. The Section 3 Action Plan applies to contracts of \$100,000 or greater and requires the Contractor to strive to meet the minimum participation level of 10% of the contract amount to be awarded to Section 3 business concerns, and 30% of all new hires shall be Section 3 residents. The Buffalo Township Municipal Sewer Authority, in accordance with Union County's Section 3 Action Plan, may provide a bid preference to a Bidder who is a Section 3 business concern. MBE/WBE and Section 3 business concerns shall be afforded full opportunity to bid without discrimination. Davis-Bacon and Related Acts apply to this Project.

All Bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the Bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or the award of a grant or grants, in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the Bid opening date as provided by the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142). The Buffalo Township Municipal Sewer Authority reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any Bid or combination of Bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority and to reject any or all proposals.
