The Project includes the following Work: Under a single contract, the project includes the construction of an approximate 6,400 S.F. new police facility, consisting of slab on grade; masonry walls; and wood roof structure. Work includes all finishes and systems, as well as some site demolition, utilities, grading, landscaping, and parking. All work shall be in conformance with Drawings and Specifications. The full Scope of Work of the Project is defined by the Contract Documents and the Plans, Drawings, and Specifications.
