QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. The current edition of NFPA 1911 is the 2017 edition. Is it correct that the aerials need to be inspected to the previous edition of NFPA 1911 as indicated in the test specifications?

1.9. All test work must be in compliance with NFPA 1911, Standard for Inspection, Maintenance, Testing, and Retirement of In-Service Automotive Fire Apparatus, 2012 Edition Chapter 19 -Performance Testing of Aerial Devices, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Answer: Please change line 1.9 to read.

1.9. All test work must be in compliance with NFPA 1911, Standard for Inspection, Maintenance, Testing, and Retirement of In-Service Automotive Fire Apparatus, 2017 Edition Chapter 19 -Performance Testing of Aerial Devices, NO EXCEPTIONS.

2. I noticed on the quotation forms for “Safety Testing of Aerials” due June 19, 2020, that there is no page 3 of the initial quote forms. Is there something missing in my forms?

Equal Employment Opportunity: In accordance with the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §48-1122, the Contractor agrees that neither it nor any of its subcontractors shall discriminate against any employee, or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this Agreement, with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because of the race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin of the employee or applicant.

Non-Discrimination: Both Parties agree that in accordance with 42 USCS 12101 et seq., the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act - Neb.Rev.Stat. §48-1122, and Omaha Municipal code 13-89, they will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment, to be employed in the performance of this Agreement, with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because of the age, race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin of the employee or applicant. E-Verify: New Employee Work Eligibility Status (Neb. Rev. Stat. §4-108-114)

A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program authorized by the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee. If the Contractor is an individual or sole proprietorship, the following applies:

1. The Contractor must complete the United States Citizenship Attestation Form, available on the Department of Administrative Services website at www.das.state.ne.us.
2. If the Contractor indicates on such attestation form that he or she is a qualified alien, the Contractor agrees to provide the US Citizenship and Immigration Services documentation required to verify the Contractor's lawful presence in the United States using the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program.
3. The Contractor understands and agrees that lawful presence in the United States is required and the Contractor may be disqualified or the contract terminated if such lawful presence cannot be verified as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-108.
