The RTC requests Bids for the manufacture and delivery of paratransit buses in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in **RTC IFB No 20-047 – 27-FOOT CNG LOW FLOOR PARATRANSIT CUTAWAY VEHICLES**. The Contract shall be a firm-fixed price Contract, which may include an annual PPI adjustment.

Specifically, the Agency is requesting the following type and quantities of vehicles, based on available funding:

A base order of up to twenty-five (25) Low Floor, Twenty Seven Foot (27') Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Cutaway Paratransit Vehicles and associated goods and services such as spare parts, training materials and manuals.

Options: Up to one hundred seventy five (175) Low Floor, Twenty Seven Foot (27') Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Cutaway Paratransit Vehicles and associated goods and services such as spare parts and manuals. The Options shall be valid for a period of five years from the effective date of the Contract.

Question	Section 26 Page 21 Paragraph 2 states the bus shall include two vertical CNG tanks mounted in enclosed compartments located in each rear corner of the bus. The tanks shall be 26" x 60" and capable of holding a minimum of 58 GGE (total). CNG tanks shall not be installed on the roof or underneath the vehicle. Will roof and under frame rails horizontally mounted tanks be acceptable in lieu of tanks mounted vertically in the rear on the bus.
Answer	CNG tanks mounted under the vehicle are unacceptable, however roof mounted CNG tanks shall be allowed, if the vehicle's overall height does not exceed the maximum height of 130" as stated on page 14, in Section 08 EXTERIOR HEIGHT, of the specification.
