Description

Clearfield City is requesting proposals from qualified firms interested in contracting to provide a central irrigation control system including components and software for the parks and open spaces owned by the City.

Project scope of work consists of the following items:

1. Supplying and installing a Central Control Unit that is able to irrigate approximately 26 sites, 100 acres of turf, trees and shrub/flower beds.
2. The Central Control Unit must be able to add additional sites for future development.
3. Clearfield City is interested in obtaining products for its Central Control Unit that will allow for reducing yearly water consumption.
4. The Central Control Unit and software will be used in new parks and to replace current components in our existing parks as they become obsolete.
5. Must be able to add irrigation controllers on sites that are currently being irrigated by DC Timers.
6. The work shall include furnishing all labor, tools, materials, equipment, transportation, and services required to supply and install the new Central Control Unit.

Prerequisites

- ★ 1. The required proposal submittals can be found in the body of the RFP.
- ★ 2. Bids must be submitted electronically through SciQuest for the sourcing event.
- ★ 3. All questions must be submitted through SciQuest during the Question and Answer period.
- ★ 4. Offerors are encouraged to review the RFP prior to the deadline to submit a proposal, even if a proposal has been submitted, in case an addendum has been issued by the City.
- ★ 5. The issuing procurement unit will not accept a bid after the time for submission of the sourcing event has expired.
- ★ 6. If it is determined to be in the City's best interest, interviews and presentations may be held with the Selection Committee.
- ★ 7. An offeror may request that part of a proposal be protected by submitting a Claim of Confidentiality in writing. The claim must include the specific reason for the claim of confidentiality and a redacted copy of the proposal; and must also be attached to the offeror's proposal at the time of submission.
- ★ 8. All proposals in response to this RFP will be evaluated by the Selection Committee in a manner consistent with the City Purchasing Policy. Offerors bear sole responsibility for the items included or not included within the proposal submitted by the Offeror. Each area of the evaluation criteria must be addressed in detail in the proposal.
- ★ 9. Offeror acknowledges the requirements to submit a proposal through SciQuest.
- ★ 10. A mandatory site visit will be conducted on Thursday, October 1, 2020 at 9:00 A.M. Those interested in submitting a proposal will meet the Clearfield City Maintenance and Operations Center (497. S. Main Street, Clearfield, UT 84015). Please plan on about 3 hours for the site visit.
