

**CITY OF COALINGA  
PUBLIC NOTICE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that sealed bids will be received by the City Engineer for furnishing all labor, materials, services and equipment, and performing all work necessary and is more specifically defined in the Contract Documents, but which generally consists of furnishing labor and materials to install and provide PLC Control Panels and other miscellaneous electrical work as specified for , but not limited to:

1. Project Records and Submittals
2. Electrical Demolition and Installation
3. PLC Control Panels and Hardware
4. SCADA Hardware and Software (all programming by application programmer)

Contractor shall note the Water Treatment Plant is to remain operational throughout the entirety of construction. Any process or portion thereof that must be interrupted for construction activities shall be coordinated and approved by the Plant Staff prior to the interruption. Contractor shall also be aware that extensive preparation will be required to coordinate the work related to the existing PLC control panels.

Project shall be structured in phases as follows:

- Phase 1 – Submit construction sequence plan for approval.
- Phase 2 – Contractor shall research and document all existing field wiring to include terminal block layout, wire number, wire color and wire size for each existing control panel. Trace and identify any signal, power or control wiring that is not shown on the P&IDs. Install temporary labels on all field (and factory as needed) wiring in existing Control Panels. Submit for approval.
- Phase 3 – Install new Filter Control Panels, test, energize and establish temporary radio communications. Label and pull all new conductors from existing to new control panels.
- Phase 4 – Install and configure fiber optic network
- Phase 5 – Decommission existing Filter Control Panels one at a time. Confirm operations and communications of each new Filter Control Panel before moving to the next filter.
- Phase 6 – Remaining work. Control panels for Raw Water pump station, Effluent pump station, Main control panel and Chemical Systems control panel. Sequence to be determined during construction. Filter control panels must be completed first.

Bids will be received for the complete work in accordance with the plans and specification on file with the City Engineer at 4630 W. Jennifer Ave, Suite 101, Fresno, CA 93722. Plans and specifications are available at the City Engineer's office. Only those who have purchased Plans and Specifications from the office of the Engineer will be considered eligible Prime Bidders. There will be a MANDATORY CONTRACTOR's Pre-Bid Meeting on October 14, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. Bidders shall meet the minimum qualifications to provide the installation described in the Contract Documents. All interested bidders are directed to meet at Coalinga City Hall, 155 Durian Avenue, Coalinga, CA 93210. **(No one will be admitted after 10:05 A.M.)**

No bid will be considered unless it is made on a bid proposal form furnished by the City Engineer. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond, made payable to the City of Coalinga, for an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. Such guarantee will be forfeited should the bidder to whom the contract is awarded fail to enter into the contract. A Performance Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount and a Labor and Materials Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount will be required by the City from the bidder to whom the contract is awarded. Said bonds shall be issued by a surety company who is an admitted surety insurer authorized by the California Department of Insurance to transact business in this state, and acceptable to the City of Coalinga. Bidders are cautioned that representations made by surety companies will be verified with the California Department of Insurance. Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, substitution of securities for any monies withheld by the City of Coalinga to ensure performance under the contract shall be permitted. In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 13 (commencing with Section 4590), Division 5, Title 1 of the Government Code of the State of California, securities may be substituted for monies withheld on the project.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 1770 of the Labor Code, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the General Prevailing Rates and wages and employer payments for health and welfare pension, vacation, travel time and subsistence pay, as provided for in Section 1773, apprenticeship or other training programs authorized by section 3093, and similar purposes applicable to the work to be done. Said wages are available from the Internet web site of the California Department of Industrial Relations at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>. A copy of the above-mentioned wage rates shall be posted by the Contractor at the job site where it will be available to any interested party.

**Engineer's Estimate: \$1,251,390.00**

All bids are to be compared on the basis of the City Engineer's estimate of the quantities of work to be done as shown in the bid proposal form. The Contractor must be licensed in accordance with the provisions of the Business and Professions Code, Division 3, Chapter 9 "Contractor". Bidders for this project must possess a valid C10 Electrical Contractor's License prior to award of the contract and will be requested to indicate the license expiration date, and the license number on the bid proposal if available. Award consideration will take place at the earliest available Council meeting or as the City Manager has been authorized to award and execute the contract. All representations made on the proposal are made under penalty of perjury.

The City of Coalinga reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or minor irregularities in the bids received, or to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder as may serve the best interest of the City of Coalinga.
