Sealed Bids for the **procurement of standby power system equipment will be received, from qualified Sellers of Goods and Services, by Ms. Diana Golt, P.E. at the Kent County Department of Public Works located at the Kent County Levy Court Building, Department of Public Works, 555 Bay Road, Dover DE until 2:00 PM local time on November 4, 2020, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Kent County may extend the time and place for bid opening, on no less than 2 calendar days' notice.** The Project consists of **procuring the equipment related to the proposed upgrade project at the Kent County RRRF which includes, but is not limited to:**

- Standby power generator system including weatherproof enclosure and medium voltage switchgear in a pre-engineered power center

Bid security for at least ten percent of the bid price is required with the bid. Bids will be accepted from Bidders who shall submit written evidence of all qualifications with their Bid as required per technical equipment specification.
