

INVITATION TO BID DUMP TRUCK(S)

BID OPTION I: One (1) NEW Dump Truck *with Plow and Sander*, Manufacturer's Standard Model in Current Year of Production, with an associated Trade-In Vehicle.

BID OPTION II: One (1) New Dump Truck *with Plow*, Manufacturer's Standard Model in Current Year of Production, with an associated Trade-In Vehicle.

Bidders may submit bids for Option I or Option II or both, however, statutory bid security shall be included with each bid submitted.

THE CITY OF RAWLINS will receive sealed bids (NO FAXED OR EMAILED BIDS) in the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, P.O. Box 953, 521 W. Cedar Street Rawlins, WY 82301, **until 2:00 p.m. on Monday, November 9, 2020**, at which time bids will be publically opened. No bids shall be considered which are received after the scheduled time. All bids will be on separate forms and in sealed envelopes clearly marked with the name of the project "**PUBLIC WORKS DUMP TRUCK WITH PLOW & SANDER**" or "**PUBLIC WORKS DUMP TRUCK WITH PLOW**" in the lower left hand corner. **With a trade-in vehicle for Bid Option I of one (1) 2007 Sterling, VIN: 2FZHATBS88AZ91063, current mileage is 51,061, unit is subject to occasional use until traded; and a trade-in vehicle for Bid Option II of one (1) 1996 International Dump Truck, VIN: 1HTSCABN7TH243327, current mileage is 75,879, unit is subject to continued use until traded.**

The "General Provisions", "Bid Form", "Invitation to Bid" and Wyoming Statute §15-1-113 are by reference made a part of the bidding documents and invitation to bid. The City of Rawlins reserves the right to accept deviations from the specifications and to waive any and all formalities or technicalities in the bidding in the sole discretion of the City. The City reserves the right to reject all bids or accept any bid, which in its sole and absolute judgment, shall under all circumstances, best serve the City's interests.

This project requires a 5% bid security in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check, business check, irrevocable letter of credit or other acceptable bid security for each bid submitted as preapproved by the city. The City may require up to 45 days after the opening of the bids for acceptance of the winning bid. Pursuant to W.S. §16-6-106 preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment machinery and provisions produced, manufactured, supplied or grown in Wyoming, quality being equal to articles offered by the competitors outside of the state.
