Questions submitted:

1. On page 15, it states there are 16 8cy dumpsters. On page 16, there are 20 listed- 1 at Lowery, 1 at AH Ray, 1 at CDI, 1at BGS Field House,1 at FLA, 1at Early Childhood, 1 at New Science Building, 1 at Moore Residence Hall, 1 at The Flats, 2 at MSX, 1 at Anderson, 1 at EJCS, 2 at Thompson, 3 at Wilson, and 3 at Physical Plant. Please confirm that page 16 is correct.

Twenty-one is the correct number. We will make the changes on the RFP. We added one to Wilson.

2. Please advise on the number of weekly dumps for Thompson Center, Wilson, and Physical Plant to calculate monthly cost on page 16.

Physical Plant – Three (M W F)

Wilson Residence Hall – Three (M W F)

Thompson Center – Six (M T W Th F S)

3. On page 16, under Cost per month for 2nd pick-up at TC, do you want that cost to be calculated for a one time per month 2nd pick-up for those 2 dumpsters? For example, if the cost to empty 1 for the second time in a day is \$10, then we would put \$20 in the cost column for 2 dumpsters times \$10. If not, please provide example.

4. Are the 30cy open top containers at Foundation Heights and Rams Common, located on campus year-round or delivered as needed?
Are we allowed to bill for rental or do we need to include rental in the haul rate? On page 17 for Total item per year for 2a, please clarify that it will be 52 total hauls per year or 26 per each 30cy open top.

The 30 cy open top containers are year-round.

Fifty-two hauls per year.

5. On page 17 under 2b, it discusses compactor hauls. Do we have to supply a compactor(s)? If so, what are the specifications? If the school owns a compactor we are to haul, please provide location and specifications.

No. The compactors have been removed. We will not have compactors on the campus.

6. On page 18, under the cost per month for the cost items for 3a and 3b's, please explain what needs to go into blanks. We are to provide pricing for these dumpsters on the previous page (17). You do not provide us with number of tons for the 3 b dumpsters but state that we will be paid per ton on page 18 so I am not sure what to put in any of these blanks. For example, 1 delivery, 1 rent, 1 haul, no tons because you are paying by weight ticket?

Enter your cost for each item. You have a charge per tonnage. Estimate the tonnage based on the size of the container.

7. On page 19, for the 30cy Metal, SSRY and Yard debris dumpsters, you are asking for a cost per month and year. Do you want us to estimate 1 months rent and 1 estimated haul and the school pays for processing, disposal etc.? To make it apples to apples, we need to have an estimated tonnage per haul if you want us to include those costs.

The tonnage per haul will vary. List your price per tonnage.

8. On page 19, under the section about 96-gallon carts, the service cost really is tied to the number being serviced. Do you want us to base our cost to service on there being approximately 100 carts? Do you want our cost to include the cart? Please confirm we only fill in the blanks for cost per week, cost per month and cost per year and not the blanks that have example by them and that cost is for 1 cart since the number has TBD.

Base cost on 55 96-gallon carts. Fill in the blanks for the cost, not the example.

9. On pages, 20 and 21, please clarify that we are to only fill in blanks for each item that pertains to that item. For example, for item 1 8 cubic yard dumpsters for trash, there are no delivery fees and rent, service and disposal are all lumped together into one charge. So, for that item, we would only fill in Total Cost per year blank and not delivery fee, monthly rental. Hauling service, etc.

Correct. Fill in the items pertaining to that item. The delivery, rental and hauling service should equal the total cost.

10. On page 7, you state the proposal submittal date is October 27 and start date is November 1. Will there be flexibility in this start date for any new vendors?

Yes.

11. In section 2b-unit prices on page 17, the bid asks for compactor haul pricing. Who owns the compactor

located between Brown Hall and Foundation Heights? Will successful bidder need to supply the compactor if it is not owned by WSSU and do you want a rental and installation price if not owned by the University? Also there used to be a compactor under the chute at Rams Commons. Are you changing to an open top at this location?

Both locations will have 30 yd open tops. We will not have compactors.

12. In section B: Recycling on page 19. Are you needing a price on the 23-gallon Slim Jim containers? I remember this being on the last bid also.

We only want a price. We are not committing to Slim Jim containers right now.
