Demolition and removal of the Vance Monument, a 65 foot tall stone obelisk, located at 4 N. Pack Square in downtown Asheville, North Carolina. Pursuant to the N.C. Gen. Stat. § 100-2.1(c), the City and County are authorized to remove the two Confederate monuments from public property. The City of Asheville is seeking bids for the removal and disposal of this monument.
