NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Bids shall be uploaded electronically to the BPXpress planroom via the “Submit Bid Docs” tab on the Year 2 Pavement Restoration Project web page <https://www.sthelenabids.com/jobs/public>, until 2:00 p.m. on Friday, July 9, 2021 (no bids will be accepted after 2:00 p.m.) for the construction of the following project:

CITY PROJECT NO. R19-79 – YEAR 2 PAVEMENT RESTORATION

The work generally consists of constructing full depth asphalt concrete repairs, pavement grinding, asphalt concrete overlays, traffic striping, crosswalk markings, sidewalk replacement, valley gutters replacement, curb and gutter repairs, ADA curb ramp upgrades, and installing signage when applicable and other miscellaneous work as described herein. The proposed work shall be performed in accordance with the plans, specifications and other contract documents.

The construction is estimated to be completed within 40 working days from Notice to Proceed.

The engineer’s estimate is \$1,033,426.90.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the City of St. Helena has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor’s license at the time that the contract is awarded. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder’s bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

The City will have no **pre-bid meeting** for this project. The site is accessible without the need for a formal meeting.

Plans and specifications are now on file in the offices of the Public Works Department at 1572 Railroad Ave, St. Helena, CA 94574, where they may be examined. Plans and specifications may be viewed and purchased at www.blueprintexpress.com/sthelen or by calling BPXpress Reprographics at (707) 745-3593. Bidding documents may also be picked up at BPXpress Reprographics at 4740 East Second Street, 29, Benicia, California, 94510. Documents incorporated by reference in these specifications will be available for review at the Public Works Department.

All bidders must purchase a complete bid set from BPXpress Reprographics in order to be considered responsive and to receive addenda notifications.

ANY BIDS RECEIVED FROM A BIDDER WHO DID NOT PURCHASE A COMPLETE BID SET FROM BPXPRESS WILL BE CONSIDERED NONRESPONSIVE, AND THEIR BID SHALL BE REJECTED.

Bids shall be **uploaded electronically** to the BPXpress planroom via the “Submit Bid Docs” tab on the Year 1 Pavement Restoration Project web page <https://www.sthelenabids.com/jobs/public> before **2:00 p.m., Friday, July 9, 2021**. Guidelines for BPXpress Online Planroom Sealed Proposal Submission are provided in Appendix C. Proposals will be timestamped by the website upon receipt and

placed in a secure location by BPXpress to be accessed only by a representative from the City of St. Helena.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein.

All contractors doing work within the City of St. Helena are required to have a City business license.

California State prevailing wage rates will be required on this project. This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Pursuant to Sections 1770, 1773, 1773.1, 1773.6 and 1773.7, as amended, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder and all subcontractors shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations wages in accordance with the standards set forth in Section 1773 for the locality in which the work is to be performed. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the office of City of St. Helena Public Works Department to view and will be made available to any interested party on request, or may be referenced at the Department of Industrial Relations website at www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/statistics_research.html. It shall be mandatory upon the Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractors, to comply with all Labor Code provisions, which include but are not limited to the payment of not less than the said specified prevailing wage rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, employment of apprentices, hours of labor and debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

Pursuant to 1771.1 of the Labor Code, a contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

Contractor and its Subcontractors shall be responsible for compliance with Labor Code Section 1776.

No bid will be accepted online after the time specified for the opening of the bids. All bids shall be submitted on the Bid Proposal Form included in these specifications. All bids will be compared on the basis of the estimated quantities shown on the Bid Proposal Form.

Cash, a certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of CITY OF ST. HELENA, negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the Bidder and acceptable surety, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total of bid, shall be submitted with each bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price and a Labor and Material Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price. Each bond shall be in the forms set forth herein, shall be secured from a surety company that meets all State of California bonding requirements, as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, and that is a California admitted surety insurer. In accordance with Section 22300 of the Public Contracts Code, securities may be substituted for monies withheld to ensure performance under this contract.


Contractors will be required to comply with the insurance requirements set forth in these special provisions.

Bids may be held by the CITY OF ST. HELENA for a period not to exceed sixty (60) calendar days from the date of opening bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders prior to awarding of the contract. The City of St. Helena reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to determine which bid is, in its opinion, the lowest bid of a responsible Bidder and in the best interest of the City to accept. The City Council also reserves the right to waive any informalities not material to cost or performance in such bids. The basis for comparing bids will be the total cost.

Each bidder is hereby informed that, upon submittal of its bid to the City in accordance with these Plans and Specifications, the bid is the property of the City. The City shall consider each bid subject to the public disclosure requirements of the California Public Records Act (Government Code section 6250, et seq.) after bid opening, unless there is a legal exception to public disclosure.
