Proposals will be opened and read aloud at the 2nd floor Conference room, 240 Constitution Boulevard, Dallas, Georgia 30132 at **10:00 AM EST July 16, 2021**. Proposals received after the designated time will not be considered. The OWNER of the project is the Paulding County Board of Commissioners. The Engineer/Architect for the project is the **Paulding County Department of Transportation**.

The approximate extent and character of the Work is generally described as follows:

Line striping and Raised Pavement Markers (RPM's) on seven (7) Paulding County roads. See below tables for summary of quantities.

Bidding Documents may be obtained upon payment of **\$50**, non-refundable. All Bids must be on the **BID PROPOSAL UNIT PRICE FORM** furnished with the Plans and Contract documents. The Completion Date of this project is **December 31st, 2021**.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond with good and sufficient surety or sureties approved by the owner for faithful acceptance of the contract, payable to, in favor of, and for the

protection of the OWNER in an amount equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total amount payable by the terms of the contract or, in lieu thereof, in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or cash in an equal amount.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish payment and performance bonds with the executed Agreement meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents and executed on the forms attached to the Agreement. The terms and time for payment are set forth in the Agreement. Requests for payments are due by the FIFTH (5th) of the month for payment by the TWENTYIETH (20th) of the month less 10% retainage. Retainage (10%) is to be held until final acceptance of the project by the Paulding County Department of Transportation.

Surety and insurance companies must have an AM Best rating of A-6 or greater, be listed in the Federal Registry of Companies holding Certificates of Authority and Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds, be licensed by the Georgia Insurance Department and the Georgia Secretary of State to do business in the State of Georgia.

All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the day of the bid opening, but OWNER may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid security prior to that date.

Owner reserves the right to award bids in whole, or in part, by the type of work to be performed, as defined by the plans and specifications for this project.

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the OWNER. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as,

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If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the OWNER at the address previously given.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive formalities and re-advertise.
