

SPECIFICATIONS

REMANUFACTURED SYSTEMS FURNITURE

GENERAL:

All electrical components provided for system shall be new replacement parts and U.L. listed

Replacement parts must meet or exceed original equipment manufacturers standard of quality for performance.

Remanufactured system shall have a minimum ten (10) year warranty.

Manufacturer shall have guaranteed availability of product necessary to complete order. Supplier shall have a qualified staff of installers and service technicians.

PANELS:

Panels shall be available in a variety of heights ranging from forty-two (42) inches to eighty (80) inches and widths ranging from twelve (12) inches to sixty (60) inches.

Panels shall have electrical and wire management capabilities in the base cavities. Panels shall be stripped and recovered on both sides with new fabric.

Panels shall include new or remanufactured top caps.

Panels shall be able to configure to either a straight, 90°, "T" or "X" configuration.

WORKSURFACES:

Work surface substrate shall be fabricated from high-density particleboard. Finished surface materials shall consist of high-pressure standard grade laminate.

Underside of work surfaces shall be sealed with top quality laminate backer sheet material, resistant to humidity and warping.

Work surfaces shall be available in depths ranging from twenty-four (24) inches to thirty (30) inches and widths ranging from twenty-four (24) inches to ninety-six (96) inches.

STORAGE:

All hang-on shelves and bins shall be sanded, primed and repainted.

Flipper doors on bins shall be stripped of original fabric and recovered with new fabric. All closed storage bins shall be available with locks.

All hang-on shelves and storage bins shall be able to support task lighting fixtures on bottom of each unit.

PEDESTALS:

All pedestals shall be compatible in size to fit under work surfaces.

All pedestals shall be equipped with a gang lock system using a master keyed removable lock.

FLAMMABILITY TEST:

All fabrics and stuffed materials must meet or exceed those described in California Technical Bulletin 117, entitled, "Requirements, Test Procedure and Apparatus for Testing the Flame Retardance of Resilient Filling Materials Used in Upholstered Furniture.

WARRANTY:

Supplier must warrant all equipment including parts and labor, against defects in workmanship and materials for a minimum of one (1) year. Warranty service may be performed at the requesting Commonwealth agency site or at the supplier's service center, however, the supplier shall be responsible for the removal, shipping, transportation, and installation costs involved with the repair or replacement. During the warranty period, manufacturer's standard warranties for equipment will apply, unless they conflict with the above warranty provisions.

WARRANTY SHALL COMMENCE WITH FINAL ACCEPTANCE AND:

- A) The supplier warrants that all equipment will perform in accordance with the published specifications and shall be free from defect in materials, workmanship, and title for a period of one (1) year from date of acceptance by the buyer.
- B) During the warranty period, supplier agrees to repair or replace any defective part(s) without charge to the using agency as outlined under these specifications. All parts removed shall become the property of the supplier.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES:

Some suppliers have offered to provide additional related services in conjunction with the furniture items they are offering to supply to the Commonwealth under this contract. The additional related services are limited to: design layout of furniture being moved from one area to another; storage of furniture until new buildings or building renovations are completed; relocation and/or reconfiguration of manufacturers' lines of furniture.

Storage charges shall not accrue until ninety (90) calendar days after receipt of a contract purchase order and the agency has indicated they still cannot accept delivery.

The suppliers that included with their bids a list of all the above services offered by them along with the associated prices are indicated in the item sheets and are attached to the contract. These services and their associated prices were not factors in bid evaluation and award of the contract. The prices will provide using agencies with better capability to determine best value in the selection of a manufacturer's product. These services are over and above the services already built into the furniture bid prices. The Commonwealth does, however, reserve the right to restrict the services, which can be procured under the contract and not to include any services if either the prices are unacceptable or services are outside of the acceptable scope of additional services. Any price updates for these services are subject to the "Option to Renew" clause and the "Price Lists" clause.

SMALL BUSINESS/SMALL DIVERSE BUSINESS:

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Department of General Services is committed to increasing the participation of Small Diverse Businesses (SDBs) and Veteran-Owned Enterprises (VBEs) in Commonwealth procurements. While this Request for Quotes is not being issued under the Department's SDB/VBE program, the Commonwealth is requesting that Contractors seek to identify and use DGS-verified SDBs and VBEs when possible.

These efforts to identify and use SDBs and VBEs may include: reviewing solicitation lists of SDB and VBE firms that are ready, willing, and able to provide required supplies or services; soliciting SDB and VBE firms as potential sources of supplies and services; dividing requirements into economically feasible tasks or quantities; establishing delivery schedules (where the requirement permits) to encourage participation by SDB and VBE firms; and using services and assistance of such organizations as the Department of General Services' Bureau of Diversity, Inclusion and Small Business Opportunities (BDISBO).
